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We can help with screening and applying for health coverage including:

- MaineCare coverage at <u>mymaineconnection.gov</u>
- Marketplace Coverage at CoverME.gov
- Sliding Scale and Free Care services at hospitals and clinics

We can help find resources for health services, such as:

- Hospital Free Care
- · Care at Sliding Fee Clinics
- Prescriptions

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MaineCare

- No cost or low-cost health coverage that pays for doctor visits, hospital care, prescriptions and more
- Family size, current monthly income, immigrations status and other factors determine what your health coverage options are
- Apply all year at MyMaineConnection.gov
- Pregnant people and children maybe eligible regardless of immigration status if they meet income guidelines.

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Marketplace - CoverME.gov

- Health coverage that pays for doctor visits, hospital care, prescriptions and more
- Most people can get help paying for it.
- · Family size, income, immigration status and other factors determine eligibility
- Enrollment happens once each year between November 1st and January 15th
- · Some life changing events might open a "Special Enrollment Period" or SEP

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COBRA

- · Full premium
- Fully compare COBRA with other options
- Employer provides information about premium and signing up
- Call the HelpLine, 1-800-965-7476, for help comparing COBRA to other options

Medicare

- Age 65 and over
- Traditional Medicare; Parts A, B, Medigap or Supplemental, and D
- Advantage Plans sold by private insurance companies
- Contact local Area Agency on Aging for help signing up

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If you don't have MaineCare or Marketplace coverage and no other health insurance options are available to you, there are programs that may be able to help.

Sliding Scale Clinics and Hospital Free Care

- Available to people with limited income or without health insurance if they qualify.
- All Maine Hospitals must provide free care to people below a certain income
 - For example, a family of four with annual income up to \$46,800 can qualify for free care at Maine hospitals. Individuals and different family members may qualify for different programs.
- · Some clinics and hospitals also offer discounts, reduced or free care for people with higher incomes.

Prescriptions and Dental Care
