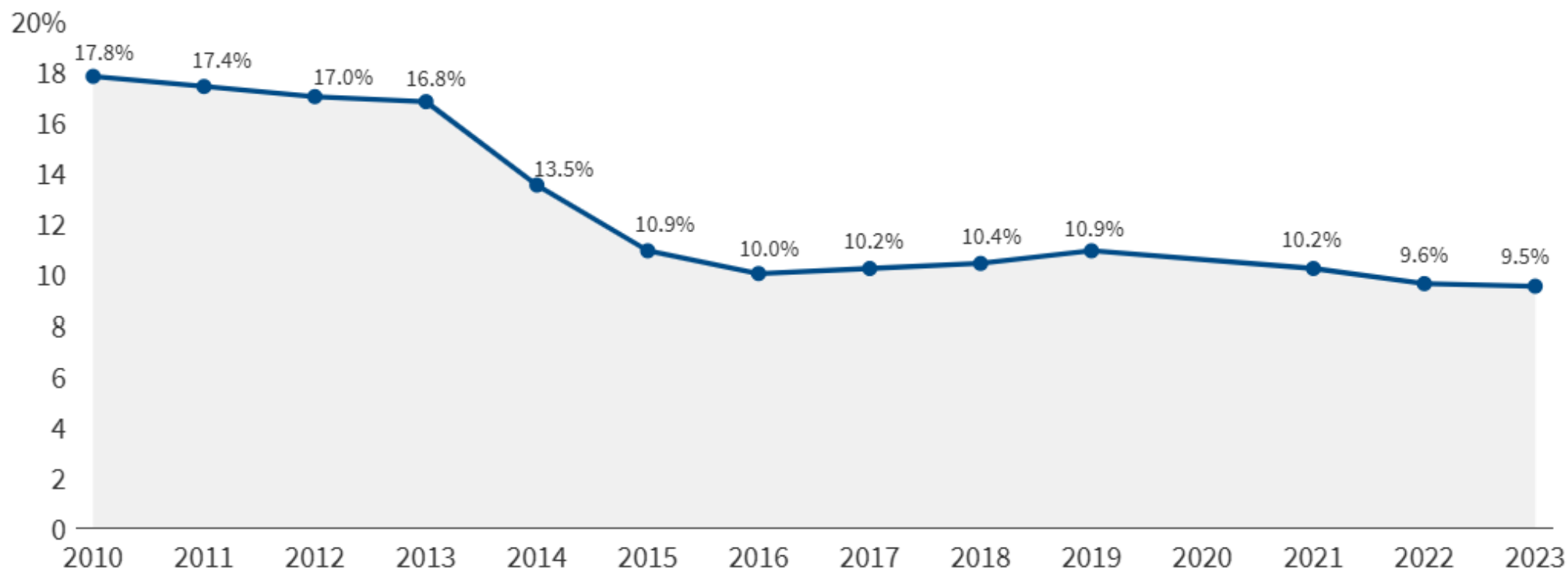

Uninsured Rate of People Ages 0-64, 2010-2023



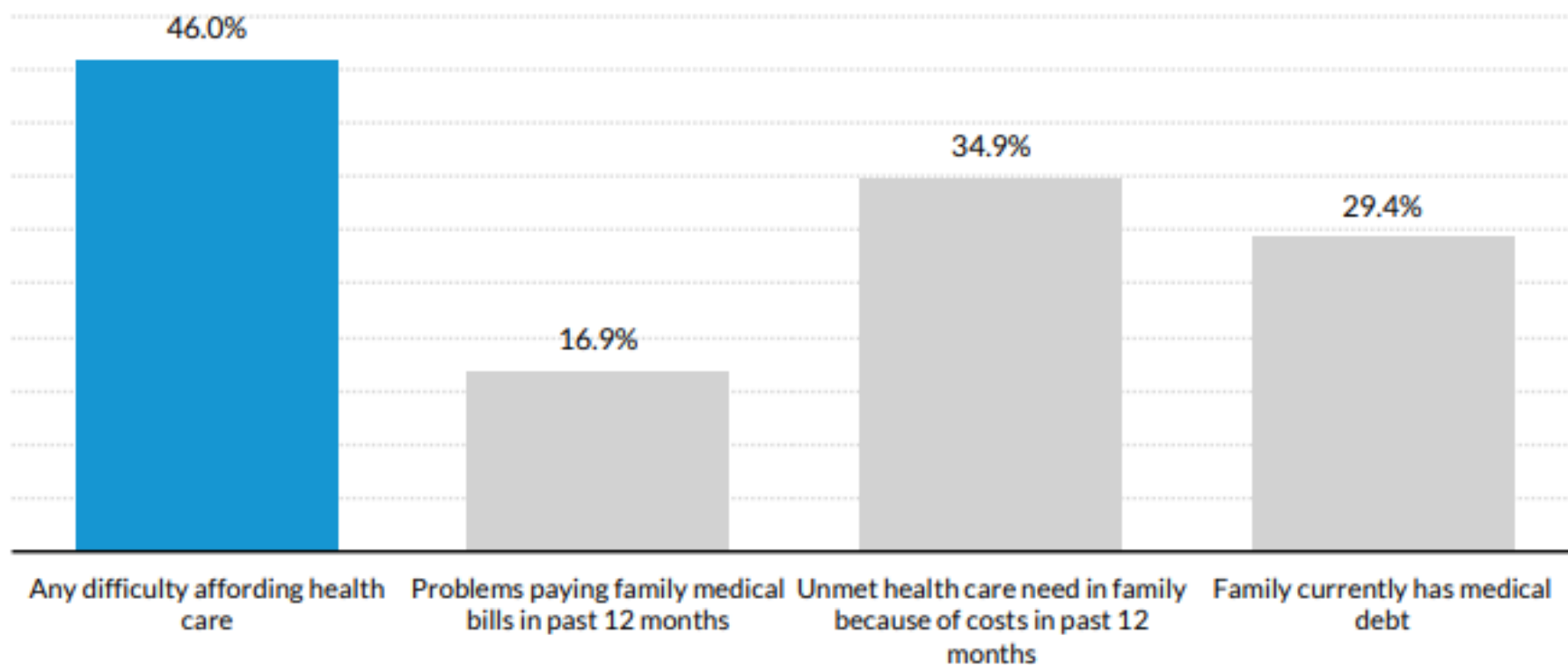

Share of Adults Ages 18 to 64 Reporting Difficulty Affording Health Care for Their Families, December 2025

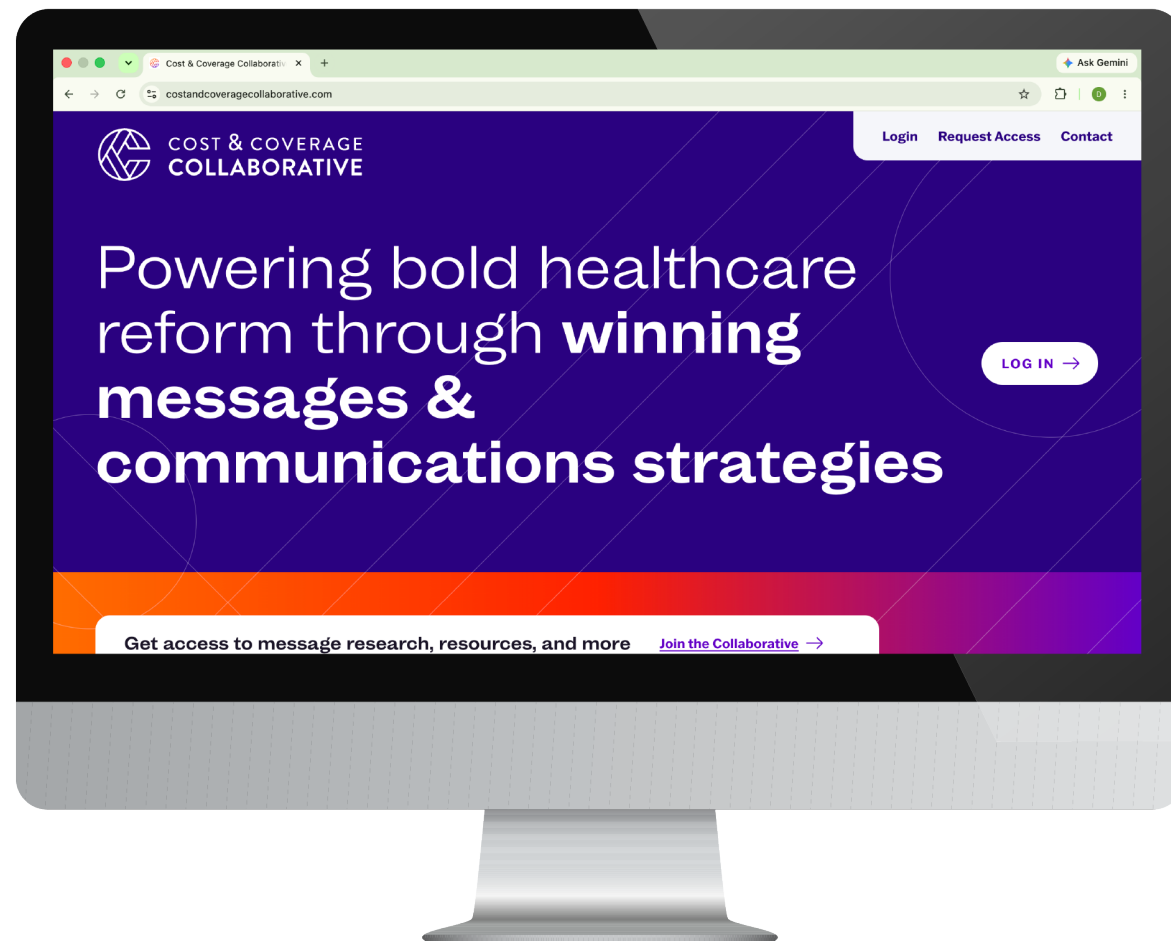

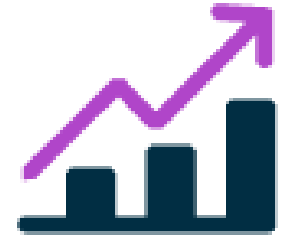
