## MaineCare

### What is MaineCare?

 MaineCare is Maine's Medicaid program. It is funded by the federal and state government. MaineCare provides free or low-cost health insurance and other health benefits to Mainers who meet certain requirements, usually based on income, disability, or age.

## What does the Office of MaineCare Services OMS do?

- OMS employees administer the MaineCare program by
  - Reimbursing health care providers for services, medication, and equipment they
    provide our members.
  - Maintaining our Medicaid policies and data.
  - Managing related program services, such as Non-Emergency Transportation (NET) and the Transforming Maternal Health (TMaH) grant.



  - A proposed rule is a rule that MaineCare is in the process of changing.
  - MaineCare will send notices through our e-messaging system anytime rules are proposed.
    - The notice will include a copy of the rule and a list of the changes being made.
  - Anyone can comment on proposed rules and the steps to comment on proposed rules can be found in the notice sent by MaineCare.
